- 5. Earnest Money Deposit. Earnest Money Deposit. Item wise EMD submission bidding is allowed. The Appendix 'C' has specified the EMD amount to be submitted for each spare/assy. The total EMD to be submitted by the bidder will be the sum of all the individual values of each spare/assy as specified in the EMD column of the Appx "C" which is being offered by the Bidder.
